- 2) Jeff Cooper presented a *Treasurer's Report* for the last fiscal year ending 6/30/2022 showing receipts of \$8,973, expenditures of \$9,670 and an ending general fund balance of \$4,024. All meeting contributions have been received. The report is accepted and attached.
- 3) A *Budget* for the 2021-2022 year was approved. The budget projects total income of \$10,020 and a small deficit of \$860. The per member contribution is raised to \$36. The cost of a Porta-John of \$120 for the past August gathering in Quaker Park will be charged to adult program. IGE has not acknowledged our previous contribution and accordingly its contribution is being given to AVP.
- 4) Friends approve the appointment of Ellerie Brownfain to the *Nominating Committee* Jamie Archer has agreed to be clerk of the Committee.
- 5) Our meeting in May of next year will be in a hybrid format. Volunteers for the technical aspects will be needed; Friends willing to provide such support should advise our Clerk. Grand Rapids has started meeting in a hybrid format and Detroit presently is meeting by zoom only, not having any space to meet in person. The Mid Winter gathering will be by zoom only. A suggested topic was anti-racism; Ann Sprague and Peggy Daub volunteered to work on planning such an event. Friends with other ideas or who also may want to volunteer should contact the Clerk.
- 6) Eight Friends attended the annual August Gathering with worship and potluck in Quaker Park in Battle Creek. While the event was dry, the forecast for rain may have reduced attendance.
