**WHAT IS IT?** Quaker Nexus or QNX is a weekend-long camp for Quakers of all ages and their friends/family hosted by Western Yearly Meeting. It is intergenerational, meaning our housing will be centered around families, couples, or a group of individuals of the same sex.

Youth who want to attend without family are required to have a participating adult that is responsible for them. Our activities will also have multiple ages in mind from young kids to those who have lived 7 or 8 decades.
